Bespoke plan for returning expeditioners

We have five Africamps planned for the summer of 2010 some of which are private teams alongside a number of people who have expressed an interest in returning to take advantage of our Bespoke program which allows returning Africampers to pick and choose and basically get involved with various elements of the full Africamp program. This allows you to revisit areas / projects / people you may have been involved with or to spread your wings and experience more of Kenya, her people and the many Moving Mountains projects around the country.

Following is an itinerary and costing for each of the separate sections that people are welcome to apply for. As a returning Africamper you will also gain a further 5% discount off the following prices. You will receive your discount card from us over the next month. The bespoke plan allows you to choose your preferred section on a pay-by-section basis and return to Kenya with a little more flexibility; essentially you are planning your own trip while still under the care of Adventure Alternative. It also means that if you would like to come to Kenya but don't want to climb the mountain again, you don't have to ☺.

The thought behind the Bespoke plan is to offer an affordable, flexible and tailor made alternative to Africamp that is still very much focused on the work that Adventure Alternative and Moving Mountains does across Kenya. We would like you to be part of this and witness first hand how Moving Mountains has a positive impact on hundreds of children's lives, there is so much more to the company and charity in Kenya and this is your chance to join a great adventure, helping people in Kenya but also helping the way we approach sustainable tourism, challenge poverty and continue to make a difference for the future.

Throughout your time in Kenya you will be accompanied by a team of staff who have lived on the streets and been through the Moving Mountains program of support and education. They are now employed by Adventure Alternative and will be your guides as

well as friends during the summer! Each of the various sections which you can get involved with will have western leaders alongside groups from the UK / Ireland.

ITINERARY & PRICES FOR BESPOKE AFRICAMP

The following itinerary is in order of camps, climbs, safaris and coast trips. Following this is a table to help you plan your adventure! Depending on how long you would like to spend in Kenya you can choose whichever sections you would like to get involved with be that any number of camps, safari's, climbs or trips to the coast.

8th – 17th July Tigithi Camp & Project – Naro Moru Price - £370

Join the Africamp team in Tigithi to work on the Africamp project and kids camp. The project will be the continuation of the classroom replacement project at the Primary School and a camp for the kids. The camp will be based in the rural and beautiful school grounds.

18th – 22nd July Nanyuki project Price - £220

Five days spent at the Nanyuki Rescue Centre to work with the street children on a one to one basis and to help the staff at the Centre to manage the place on a daily basis. This is a great opportunity to experience first hand the difficulties that face the staff and the day to day difficulties that the street children encounter.

22nd – 30th July Nairobi Camp Price - £370

Based in Nairobi, staying at either our Guest House or Rowallan Scout Centre on the outskirts of Africa's largest slum - Kibera. The program includes visits to many of Nairobi's highlights, MM projects and the slums of Nairobi. There will be an opportunity to train and play with our Black Cats Football Team and to explore deeper in to the slums to visit and experience the realities of life in the poorest areas of Nairobi and seeing how our family support program works alongside running a camp for all the kids.

29th July – 7th Aug Embu Rescue Centre and Camp Price - £370

Embu is where Moving Mountains is probably witnessed at its rawest with many of the children still living rough. Here we have worked hard and made a huge difference to many of the kids in the program and continue to involve more and more children in the rehabilitation process. We will also be running a camp and a project in Embu and doing tours and visit days.

20th – 29th Aug Climb Mt Kilimanjaro Price - £975

Climb Kilimanjaro to the roof of Africa! Full Kilimanjaro details for this heavily discounted expedition are on our website or email us for an info pack. The usual price is £1195! If you do Kilimanjaro with no other Kenyan options then the price is £1095

29th Aug – 1st Sept Post Kilimanjaro 4 day / 3 night Serengeti Safari Price - £400
